## Mount (tent) tain experience

While Jesus, Moses and Elijah were conversing about their mountain experience through which each of them was strengthened to commit more fervently, Peter was concerned about pitching tents to gaze upon the glory continuously. The shift of emphasis from staying put on the mountain to suffering beneath the mountain for and with the people is evidently expressed in the words of Jesus.

Against the preceding context of Jesus' prediction of his suffering and death, the transfiguration is merely a glimpse of glory before the disciples see the gory face of Jesus at Gethsemane and Calvary. The disciples, blinded by Jesus' brilliance and flattened by fear, are advised to get up and keep going for the terminus which was going to be the other mountain - Calvary. The path of glory was and will never be a bed of roses but of bushes and thorns - suffering and death.

Standing in line with Peter, we find joy in erecting earthly 'tents' which are tentative and transitory. By doing so, we can lose sight of the eternal dwelling place. In the words of St. Paul, "We know that the earthly tent we live will be destroyed one day and we will be longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling - a tent of eternal glory". Christ crucified/glorified on Calvary is the reason for Christians to glory in.

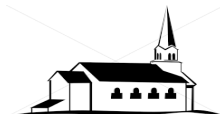
