Opening the 'graves'

Lazarus is evidently found in the ranks of those ordinary people in John's gospel (a Samaritan woman and a blind man) who became extra-ordinary in their faith and were greatly commended by Jesus for being and becoming so. His few days in the tomb foreshadows Jesus' three days in the tomb. It made a huge difference in the life of Lazarus to picture the resurrection of Jesus and illumined the minds of the Apostles to know how much it would take for them to taste that joy.

Jesus' opening of the tomb of Lazarus is figurative of what we need to do to encounter Him – to allow the Spirit to blow open the 'graves' of our pride, selfishness and hatred. By untying the knots of Lazarus, Jesus invites to untie the 'knots of evil attitudes' – hypocrisies, bitterness, jealousy, lust and lack of forgiveness - so as to free us up to joyfully proclaim and become the witnesses of the gospel.

Next week we begin the Holy Week, spiritually the most appealing days of our faith journey. Let us set aside a considerable amount of time in solitude and prayer so as to unite ourselves with the passion of our Lord. Please refer to the Holy Week schedule carefully and plan on attending the services, marking them as the top most priorities.
