The 'spirit' of the law binds

We often reduce Christianity to a long list of *don'ts*, forgetting that the true essence of it is the 'spirit' behind the laws. Jesus proposes a new interpretation of the old Law with a series of so-called 'antithesis', which follow a common pattern. A radically new approach to the age-old moral codes, indeed!

Jesus enlarges the prohibition of murder to embrace anger, the prohibition of adultery to include lustful glances, and the prohibition of false oaths to include any kind of swearing, since a simple 'yes' or 'no' is equally binding. Jesus does not espouse a minimalist approach to morality. Nor his new law is a soulless set of *don'ts*. It involves not merely overt behavior but scrutinizes our inner motive. 'Love' matters a lot, more than the 'laws', for a faithful follower.

Following Jesus demands prudent obedience, not to the letter of the law but to its inner spirit that animates and activates. Seeking to transcend every form of legalism, Jesus warns us that we would never get into the kingdom of heaven unless our virtue and behavior get deeper than that of the Pharisees.

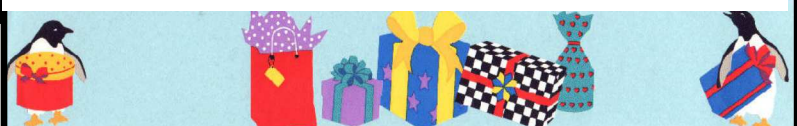

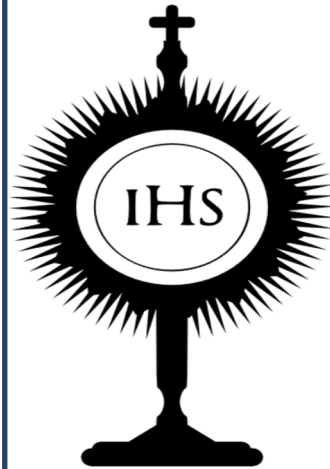

24 HOURS WITH THE LORD



The Sacred Heart Parish Lenten Retreat this year will be Eucharistic Adoration for a 24-hour period beginning after morning Mass on Friday March 17 until 8am Saturday March 18. This will not be a formal guided retreat, but rather the chance for the whole Parish to participate in Adoration of the exposed Blessed Sacrament. Your part is to commit to spending one hour (at least) with the Eucharistic Lord.

This is the time meant to be spent as just you and Jesus, a chance to find quiet and let Him have in turn talking to you! The only real requirement for your period of adoration is to maintain quiet and reverence. You may read, silently recite the Rosary, pray as you see fit or try to enter into contemplation of our God.

It is very important that you keep your appointment with the Blessed Sacrament, as we must have at least two people present at all times when the Eucharist is exposed. Please sign-up for a time you are sure you can keep. If you have any problems whatsoever getting to the church on time, or your relief person is late, you will need to contact the Adoration coordinator to ensure the Blessed Sacrament is not left alone in the church.

It is sure that the Lord rewards those who keep watch with him with abundant graces: not only for you personally, but for those you pray for, our Parish family, the entire Church and indeed the world. Our Blessed Mother has reminded us again and again that there is much to pray for and little time. Let us take her urgings to heart and watch just one hour with Him, as he requested Peter, John and James do as He entered into his Passion, which is our salvation.
