Staying with and sending forth

The 'Emmaus' episode evoked lots of positive thoughts in the minds of Apostles, who lived in the midst of a chaotic and confusing situation. The reenactment of the last supper coupled with the breaking of the word marks the first celebration of what we now call, "Mass", solemnly inaugurated by none other than our Eternal High Priest – Jesus.

While the apostles requested Jesus to stay with them, He, in turn, after opening their hearts and minds to the understanding of the paschal mystery, sent them out into the world to become his ambassadors. With the promise of his continual presence and constant protection He commissioned them to become the faithful witnesses. The mission has been accomplished only because they remained connected to Him.

Pope St. John Paul II exhorted us with these words to emulate Emmaus-disciples: "The human heart, oppressed by sin, at times disoriented and exhausted, tried by sufferings of all sorts, is in need of light. Every Christian, by virtue of his/her enlightenment through the reception of the sacramental graces shoulders the responsibility of bringing that light to illumine in others". Let Jesus' Eucharistic word-breaking and bread-breaking sensitize us to take up the mission worldwide.
