The Ascension

70,000 Pounds of Fresh Produce

The Tillamook Knights of Columbus has given around 70,000 pounds of produce over the past 5 years to the local food bank. Special thanks to Don Armstrong who was the projects architect and many other Knights and community members who gave their time so charitably. I'm sorry to report the K of C will not be planting a garden this year, but whenever God closes a window he always opens a door. We are asking for your help this year to plant some extra produce in your garden, your neighbors, a planting basket, anywhere you can find a place for some seeds. The K of C will provide all the seeds for Free. Later in the summer/fall when the produce is ripe we will have a collection station for you to bring all the produce to be donated. We may even come out and help you harvest or arrange a produce pick up at your house if needed. If this is an opportunity in which you would like to get involved with please contact Joe Solis by e-mail at JSolisNW@hotmail.com or sign up for some seeds on the sign-up sheet at the back of church. We would like to start with crops such as potatoes, corn, onions, squash and cabbage. If you plan on emailing me please indicate your name and how much seed you will be planting so we can get an estimate as to how much seed to buy. For example: 5 potato plants and three rows of corn 10 feet in length. If you have any questions please feel free to email me. If you have a spot where someone could grow crops or would love to grow crops but don't have a spot please contact me and see if we can accommodate you.
