Eucharist – ‘U’ (we) are Christ!

The Eucharist, echoed as the ‘source and summit of our faith’ in the Vatican Council documents, presents us with a herculean task of living the qualities it signifies, namely unity and sacrifice. While the Eucharistic overtones of St. Paul’s exhortation in his epistles emphasize the notion of unity, Pope Paul VI, widely accorded with the distinction as the Pope of the Eucharist, for his special devotion to this mystery, brought out through his preaching and writings the notion of sacrifice.

The sacrificial aspect of Jesus’ death is reiterated in the gospels, especially in the fourth one, where the evangelist uses ‘flesh and blood’ terminology signifying the ‘whole man’ Jesus. Thus, Word-become-flesh now invites the believers to ‘eat his flesh’ and ‘drink his blood’ to effect communion with him and his supreme sacrifice.

“The Eucharist is an act of faith...May this body immolated and this blood sacrificed for humankind nourish us also, so that we may give our body and blood, like Christ, for others”, Blessed Archbishop Oscar Romero of En Salvador preached on March 24, 1980. Minutes later, while raising the chalice during consecration, he was shot dead. Thus, he became the Eucharistic symbol for his people. Such is the challenge given to us!
