Crossroad to Calvary

After his glorious declaration about Jesus’ Messiah-identity in last week’s gospel, the newly-installed leader, Peter, harbors dreams of Jesus overthrowing Roman rule or controlling Jerusalem’s temple-authority. Not only is Jesus disinterested in fulfilling these false hopes, but he actually preaches, through the predictions for more than once, about death as the doorway to life, in other words, He embarks upon the “Crossroad to Calvary”.

Peter’s resistance to the Crossroad is understandable. Most of the people in his time expected the Messiah to seek power, not to suffer pain, to be crowned, not to be crucified. Peter’s anti-Calvary stance is anti-Christ as well and therefore deservedly deemed devilish. Any of our attempts to seek power and glory is certainly satanic and stands just opposite to Christ.

Jesus corrects Peter’s (and ours too) thinking. Our way is self-seeking, Gods way is self-sacrificing: we seek to be loved and served, Jesus seeks to love and serve. Worse, our ways are constantly at cross-purposes with the Crossroad of Christ. Thus, we bring doom and death, whereas the Cross leads to life and liberation. Are we ready to tread the Crossroad with Christ?

The Priest

Nowhere does a parish community show forth the mystery of the Church more clearly than in the celebration of Holy Mass. The Mass requires the presence and ministry of a priest. Like John the Baptist, the priest is the “friend of the Bridegroom” (John 3:29), rejoicing in the union of Christ with his Bride, the Church. The priest effectively fosters that union by standing at the head of the assembly, by presiding over its prayer, by preaching the Word of God, and by offering the Sacrifice of Christ in the Holy Spirit to the Father.

“When he celebrates the Eucharist, therefore, he must serve God and the people with dignity and humility, and by his bearing and by the way he says the divine words he must convey to the faithful the living presence of Christ” (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, art. 93).

The priest must be ablaze with what John Paul II calls “Eucharistic amazement” (Ecclesia de Eucaristia, art. 6). When the priest speaks the words of consecration first uttered by Christ in the Upper Room, he places his voice and his whole being at the disposal of the Lord. Then, awed by what happens on the altar before which he stands, he proclaims the presence of the Mystery of Faith in the midst of the Church. Everything in the life of the priest flows into this moment, and flows out of it.
